

## Clinical Attendance - pre-licensure programs (ABSN & ASN)

Attendance at all scheduled clinical experiences is essential to the student's education.

- The student is expected to arrive at the scheduled destination prepared to participate in clinical in a safe manner.
- If the student is unable to be present at a clinical experience, including skills laboratory sessions, it is their responsibility to verbally contact the faculty member and the clinical site prior to the scheduled start time. Failure to complete appropriate notification of absence or clinical make up may result in failure of the course.
- Clinical absences from a course are considered problematic and may result in failure of the course.
  - The first clinical absence within a course will result in clinical make-up utilizing simulation activities or face-to-face clinical time.
  - The second clinical absence within a course will result in an additional clinical day through face-to-face clinical time.
  - Missed clinical days beyond two per clinical course will result in course and clinical failure.
- Faculty reserve the right to identify mandatory clinical experiences that would be required to be made up in the specific clinical area missed which may include but are not limited to ED, ICU, School Nurse Visit, GI lab, Infusion, etc.
- The student will be charged a fee for all hours requiring clinical make-up, regardless of type of makeup.
